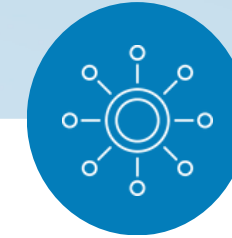

OpenAI Defense Victory in Elon Musk Lawsuit

Situation: In this highly publicized litigation and trial, Elon Musk accused OpenAI and cofounders Sam Altman and Greg Brockman of “stealing a charity.”

Our Role: Compass Lexecon experts were retained by counsel for OpenAI to act as consultants and expert witnesses in the litigation. They analyzed economic, financial, nonprofit governance, and AI safety issues to support OpenAI’s defense. Their work included expert reports, depositions, live trial testimony, and written direct testimony.

Outcome: Following a three-week trial on the issues of liability, the jury returned a unanimous verdict after less than two hours of deliberation, finding that Mr. Musk had brought his lawsuit outside the statute of limitations. The Court accepted the jury’s unanimous decision and dismissed Mr. Musk’s claims.

Meta Antitrust Suit

Situation: In 2020, the FTC sued Meta seeking to undo its 2012 and 2014 acquisitions of Instagram and WhatsApp and to break apart the company, claiming that Meta was a monopolist in the market for “personal social networking.”

Our Role: Meta and its counsel retained Compass Lexecon to act as consultants and experts in the case. Over the course of the roughly five-year litigation, six of our experts filed reports and testified at depositions. At trial, two of our experts provided theoretical and empirical responses to the FTC’s primary wide range of claims and testified about market definition based on a groundbreaking field experiment.

Outcome: In November 2025, the Court released its opinion finding that “Meta holds no monopoly in the relevant market” and entered judgment in Meta’s favor.

UnitedHealth Group/Amedisys Merger

Situation: UnitedHealth Group’s \$3.3 billion acquisition of Amedisys was challenged by the US Department of Justice. The DOJ alleged that combining Amedisys with UnitedHealth’s prior acquisition of LHC Group would reduce competition in the market for home health and hospice services.

Our Role: The merging parties retained Compass Lexecon to testify about the competitive effects of the proposed merger and address the divestiture proposal put forward by the merging parties.

Outcome: The DOJ reached a settlement with the parties involving divestiture of facilities, allowing UnitedHealth Group to complete its acquisition of Amedisys.
